Dear Don,

I am writing to let you know how much Seaquest Phosphate has done for 2 of the water systems that I oversee and operate. I use Seaquest at both of my municipal wells for Pike County Water & Sewer Authority, a system that serves over 500 customers in Pike County. At both of my wells, I have had water quality issues with manganese and iron along with almost daily customer complaints about the discoloration of the water. You recommended Seaquest at both of these wells many years ago, and in both cases Seaquest has handled those problems. I have not had a discoloration complaint in 4 years in that system.

I also oversee a new water permitted business at the Chic-fil-A Rock Ranch in Upson County, GA. This system received its EPD permit 2 years ago.
